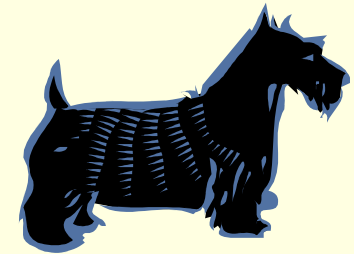

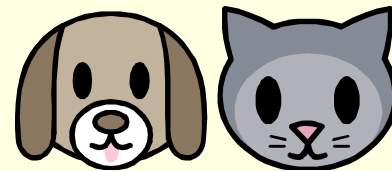

 - Eliminated Life Expectancy Clause
 - Vaccinate / Test on Intake
 - Launched New Web Site
 - Instantly Updated
 - Photos Uploaded within 24-48 hrs
 - Blankets, Toys and Bones in Cages
 - Donated Items

Change Implementation (cont.)

- Changes made since the start of 2010 (cont.)
 - Health Guidelines revised to Standard Operating Procedures
 - “14 day” clause eliminated to create 30 day clause
 - Asilomar Accord Definitions Implemented
 - Vaccination Protocol
 - Bordatella
 - booster

Change Implementation (cont.)

- Changes made since the start of 2010 (cont.)
 - Veterinarian Spay/Neuter available Tuesday and Thursday
 - Stainless Steel Litter Trays Ordered

 - Spay / Neuter Equipment
 - Surgical Room Expansion
 - Low Cost Spay / Neuter Clinics
 - Training / Education
